About The Scholarship

The John Davis Memorial Scholarship Fund is awarded to help people with disabilities who want to return to college; to community colleges or career institutes, for four-year degrees or graduate education. This scholarship opportunity is also open to students who would like to pursue an education directly related to a career in human services to further support people with disabilities with success in their life's vision.

Summary of Scholarship Requirements

1. Submit a short essay (1 or 2 paragraphs) that demonstrates an interest in personal development as related to the purpose of The John Davis Scholarship fund.
2. Submit most recent original transcript, does not have to be officially sealed.
3. Submit the scholarship application.

Requirements

The applicants selected with financial need, will display self-determination, a commitment to serving others (in school, their community, or at home), a strong work ethic, and inclusive qualities. This scholarship is open to all students with diverse abilities and varied support needs. Applicants must be a high school senior, possess a high school diploma, or GED, and must be planning to enroll in an accredited college, university, or career institute within the United States.

How to Apply

The scholarship award may be granted to High School students or someone receiving DDS services in the Brockton area.
